



PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS:

HOPE365plus is a program developed through a partnership with Partners in Hope & Healing and Man in the Mirror to provide mentors to specific program graduates and age-outs who might otherwise not have the minimum guidance necessary to get a good start in life.

CLaMP or Christian-Life Mentoring Program is developed specifically for Adult & Teen Challenge Reentry Participants to help them help to develop or redevelop life-skills, learn how to allow God to develop them spiritually, and lead them in the direction of success in life and relationships.

FOR THE CHURCHES:

This is a new and unique opportunity to do more than any church program has ever done to help reduce recidivism in previously addicted people. What makes this different from other church-based programs is that you are not asking your members to host a program to help addicts get clean; you are asking them to help a freshly inspired man or woman to walk in Christ with them and introduce to them what a Christian calls normal. By helping guide these folks toward quality spiritual formation, you help to envelope them in the kingdom of God and will see them inspire may others to join the kingdom and the church. Asking your members to mentor these ladies and gentlemen is the same as asking them to mentor people in your church. Many of these folks are

new Christians who already understand the basics of being a Christian, but need a wise person to show them how to employ their new morality, value system, and gifts in a life that glorifies God.

Julie,

1. Set up event announcements for social media (Mark to do artwork and implementation)
2. Help Jody draft an invitation letter to designated churches (TC will provide list Jody and will figure out how to get them to the churches).
3. Set program for event speakers. Time, Individual content, etc.
4. Director of Client Success, and founder of Path to Purpose
5. (Introduce Purpose of Program)
6. Zack to introduce the need for the program
7. (present the plan for: Tools for Client Success)
8. Theme: Yellow and Green (Yellow = Partners and bright future / Green = Hope365 and Go!

Bill,

1. Secure facility (to be done when we are ready to set a date)
2. Develop Training Program
 - a. Be innovative – remember this is a special pilot program that MiM agreed to participate in. They (you) can be very flexible in the interest of kicking this thing off.
 - b. It needs to be very easy for mentors.

- c. We need to assign mentors ASAP to reduce drift and maintain momentum.
 - d. Can do online in live zoom class (we have the ZOOM platform)
 - e. Live classes should be recorded for those who cannot attend at designated times.
 - f. Consider a group training program (with a quad supervisor who is also a mentor or is a pastor interested in directing his members through the program)
3. (Introducing Mentor Training Program)
- a. Bill Dodge, Director of Mentoring Success and NE Florida Director of MiM.
 - b. Identify that CLaMP is based on the understood needs of Teen Challenge graduates and is guided by a proven mentoring program offered to churches by Man in the Mirror. This program is used under license by PIHH in a tailored way that suits the needs of the Adult & Teen Challenge reentry program. Male and Female mentoring coaches receive training using a hybrid of the 10k Spiritual Father program, which is a program also available directly to your church for internal mentoring programs.
